



New Alcohol Laws 2021



Cocktails to Go

Effective 8/25/2021 for Mixed Beverage license holders



Must be sealed, non-malleable, rigid container containing no sipping holes or openings for straws and must be placed in trunk of car

- 1) Label containing type & name of alcohol;
- 2) Name, license #, & address of licensee;
- 3) Ingredients, volume, and date filled (must be within 7 days of sale)



Must verify age and that customer is not intoxicated



No 3rd party delivery



No Polystyrene, light plastic, foil pouches, or paper

Patron Self-Pour

Effective 11/1/2021 for Mixed Beverage and Beer and Wine



Must have video monitoring and keep footage for at least 60 days and shall supply to ABLE or other law enforcement upon request



Must use a RFID device to monitor usage



Customer must produce a valid driver's license, identification card, or other government issued document



10 oz wine

Limit per customer per active RFID device



32 oz beer

Samples on Retail Settings

Effective 11/1/21 for Retail Liquor, Retail Beer, and Retail Wine Licensees



Licensee must have purchased and paid taxes on alcohol used for samples



Must be 21 or older to sample

Daily limit per customer



OR



OR



1 oz of spirits 2 oz of wine 3 oz of beer

Must be consumed on licensed premise, not removed

Must be poured by licensee and from original sealed packaging



No more than 6 beverages unsealed at any given time
Must pour out beer & wine at end of the day
